Contest Description:

- Contestant will perform a basic manicure on the left hand only, including filing, soaking, softening and pushing back the cuticles, hand massage and red polish application. (Following State Board Procedure)
- On the right hand, **Index Finger**, contestant will perform one sculptured nail using form. Pink and White Application.
- On the right hand, **Middle Finger**, contestant will apply one nail tip only, blended to the natural nail. (No polish)
- On the right hand, **Ring Finger**, contestant will apply one tip with overlay using acrylic system. (No polish)
- On the right hand, **Little Finger**, contestant will apply nail wrap on natural nail using a fiberglass system. (No polish)

Contestant will supply all tools and supplies (no electric filing)

Any odorless acrylic nail system may be used

Nail model must have at least 1/8" of free edge.

PURPOSE:

- To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment, and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in their field of Cosmetology/Esthetics

Clothing Requirements:

- Students are to dress in black pants, black closed toe shoes, white blouse and uniform smock. There should be no identification or name of school on smock.

Equipment and Materials:

Contest Description:

- Model must have no make-up, facial piercing or jewelry on prior to contest. Model must have hair pulled away from face with a headband. Model must have pre-cleaned face free of any make-up
- Set-up can only consist of items needed for the specific application in progress. Time will be allowed between each contest to reset table. All products and solutions must be labeled. Required implements and products must be accounted for and professionally organized.

- Contestant must bring a typed or hand written, brief description of the theme they intend to create for the Fantasy Make-up application on a 3 x 5 index card.

Daytime Make-up Application

- Contestants must have their own model. The model must have hair pulled away from face and have no make-up to start. The contestant will complete a full-face daytime make-up application. All work must be completed by hand and finished in 30 minutes.

Evening Make-up Application

- Contestants will transform the daytime make-up into a complete evening make-up application. Colors should conform to the model's skin tones. All work must be completed by hand in 30 minutes.

Fantasy Make-up

- Time will be allowed for the model's face to be cleansed prior to fantasy make-up application. Work will be done on model. All work must be done during the fantasy make-up application. No prep time will be allowed.
- Items allowed for the fantasy make-up application:
 - Make-up designed to be used on the face
 - False eyelashes
 - Rhinestones
 - Glitter
 - Theatrical accessories
 - Hair ornaments
